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The Don't Buy In Project is a diversity and hate/bias program for local junior and senior high schools. This program provides schools with the skill development, information and resources needed to support an environment that actively addresses issues of hate, bias and discrimination.

The **Calgary Police Service** offers these presentations at no cost and would be pleased to come out and talk to the students at your school or community agency. The presentations include information around hate/bias crimes and/or incidents, active witness skill training, a resource tool kit, role-plays and scenarios, informative website **www.dontbuyin.ca** and a fun, interactive jeopardy-style game called Diversity Challenge. Through the implementation of this program we will raise awareness of our diverse communities for Calgary youth, empower them to respond effectively to hate/bias incidents and ultimately

prevent the occurrence of hate/bias crimes in our schools and community.



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The length of the presentation is approximately two hours but our program is very flexible and there is always the option of doing the presentation in two parts. The Don't Buy In Project can be presented to large groups but smaller groups allow for more interactive activities and discussion.
