Synergy Youth and Community Development Society	Synergy's Youth Internship program provides youth ages 15-21 with meaningful work experience and opportunities for skill development that directly target barriers youth encounter when applying for jobs. This program runs through the summer months where youth will volunteer a minimum of 100 hours engaging in youth programs, community projects, and training sessions to help them learn and practice long-lasting skills. When youth complete the required hours, they are awarded a \$500 bursary to recognize their incredible work and to aid them in future education opportunities.
