WHAT IS IT?

- Your community will work with Master of Planning graduate students from the School of Architecture, Planning and Landscape (SAPL) from the University of Calgary to identify issues regarding density, physical planning, urban design and land use, to create a visioning document for the community



WHAT ARE THE BENEFITS?

- Communities will build knowledge, understand the needs of their communities and will be able to make better informed decisions about their communities
- Gather feedback from stakeholders and receive design interventions based on sound planning principles
- Opportunity for community members to lead the planning process



WHAT DO STUDENTS PRODUCE?

- Students may create a variety of visual products, like maps and diagrams, to assist you in expressing your community's future vision
- For example, students may provide you with maps, data, policy reviews, 3D renderings, physical 3D model, or other products tailored to your needs

WHAT TO EXPECT

- **End of January:** 1 community walkabout with students and a few board members
- **Mid February, mid March and mid April:** 1 or 2 board members to seat on the steering committee, the steering committee will have 3 meetings with the students
- **End of February:** Attendance at 1 community workshop, which is open to all members of the community. Important that residents, businesses, stakeholders attend. Active participation is needed
- **Mid April:** Attendance at 1 public open House, which is open all members of the community



WHAT ARE THE DEADLINES AND TIMELINES?

- The application opens on September 23 and will close on November 15, 2019
- November 25 to 29, interview with SAPL
- December 2, successful candidates will be notified
- 3rd week in January 2020, project will start
