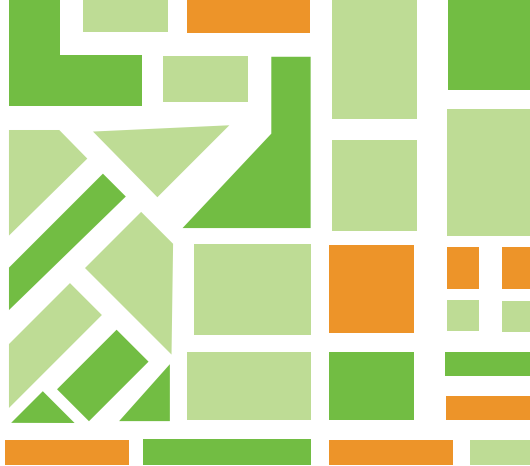

## IS A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION?

Community associations are neighbourhood-based volunteer organizations working to provide social, educational, and recreational opportunities for their residents.



# WHAT

## IS THE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS AND RESIDENT ASSOCIATIONS?

Membership in a resident association (RA) is mandatory. They manage and maintain amenities like lakes, golf courses, and road landscaping. Community association membership is voluntary.



# WHY

## SHOULD YOU BUY A COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION MEMBERSHIP?

- Community associations are the hub of activities in their communities and provide a voice for the community with The City of Calgary.
- You can join your community association to enjoy programming and discounts to local businesses, and to participate in civic engagement.
