

The City of Calgary Downtown Strategy team ran the Winter City Design Competition this year and had installations that were to be decommissioned in March.

They reached out to us and we put out a call out to our member CAs that this installation was up for grabs! On the very same day it was taken down, it was delivered to its new home in Bowforth Park.

Installed on March 25, Downtown West CA is excited to give this installation a new home in their community that was previously lacking a gathering space. Residents needed a communal green space that encouraged neighbourliness, so this was the perfect first step to placemaking in Downtown West. They'd like to use this as a gateway for future placemaking, too!

Speaking of using it as a gateway, Downtown West CA isn't stopping there with placemaking in Bowforth Park. **They'll also be using an Activate YYC grant to add colourful seating** that matches the mural to create an overall cohesive and playful environment! Talk about turning space into place!
