





Activate YYC focuses on tactical urbanism, small temporary low-cost initiatives that help change how people use and interact with spaces. Tactical urbanism initiatives spark neighbourly conversations that build community connection, increase the movement of residents in a community, and create safer streets.

Many of our projects put The City processes to the test and some even lead to permanent changes!



Exploring Communities

Focusing on unused spaces or "placemaking," students work with four communities each year to create a unique project identifying demographics, needs, and amenities unique to each community. In the fall of every year, we seek member organizations who want to spark some new ideas and reimagine space with the help of students!

Exploring Communities is a community program we offer in collaboration with an Urban Studies class from the University of Calgary.

LloydSadd A NAVACORD Action Grants

Lloyd Sadd Action Grants (formerly Toole Peet) are small, barrier free microgrants, up to \$1,000 each, that support Federation member organizations to re-engage with their residents, as they see fit. Winners of the Action Grants will be drawn from all organizations who apply!

The next round of awards are coming fall 2024!
