- Engage in hands-on work, including building, painting, and organizing events.
- Project management and execution.
- Plan and execute demonstration activations led by the Federation.
- Engage local communities in building capacity for replicating urban activations.
- Create resources to support the simple replication of activations (e.g., tip sheets, workshops, manuals).
- Handle administrative responsibilities such as budgeting and data tracking.
- Prepare and provide summary reports of projects with recommendations for future improvement.
- Take proactive measures to minimize risks and maximize opportunities for the organization.
- Communicate project outcomes through storytelling and communications.
