Preserving Natural Resources

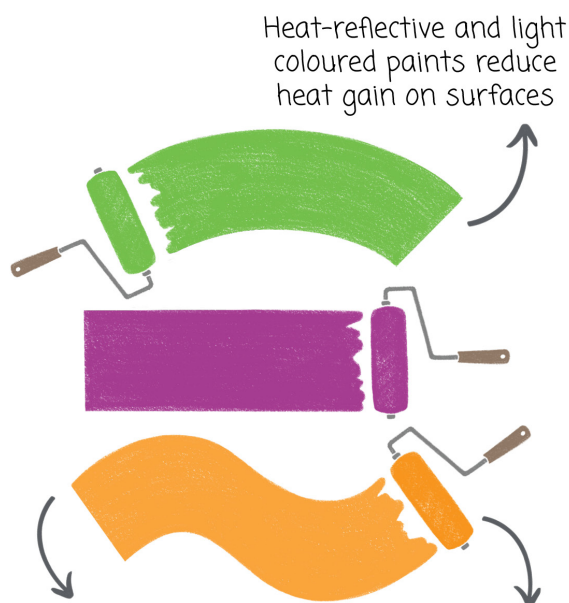


Using rain barrels to water your garden helps reduce the use of tap water

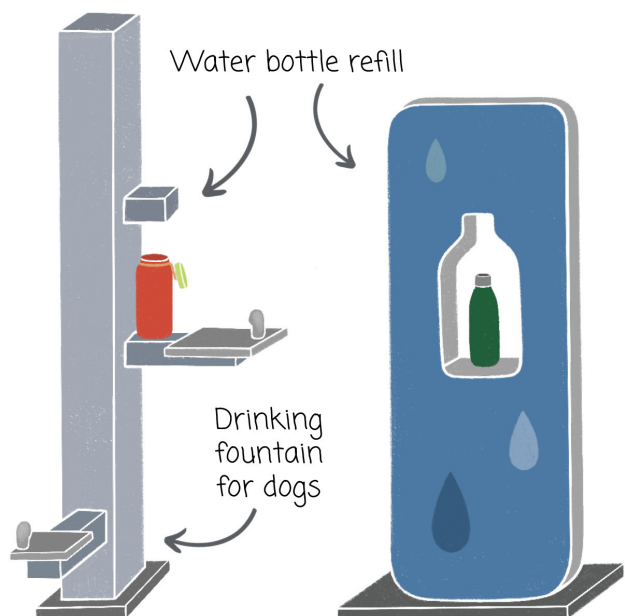
