Some indicators:

- Acquiring/ possession of military type equipment (eg, gas masks);
- Acquiring/ possession of material that could contain irritant chemical agents (cayenne pepper, smoke bombs, extinguishers, etc.);
- Acquiring/ possession of dual use materials or weapons;
- Possession of items that can be thrown or used for vandalism;
- Presence of a suspicious substance;
- Change in appearance or dress style;
- Change in the way of thinking and interacting with others;
- Suspicious training or weapons handling activities (virtual or real);
- Implicit or explicit threats (eg, on social media or blogs);
- Rejection of the State (politics and social values);
- Participation in radical activities or demonstrations and the use of extremist language;
- Overconsumption of hate and violent propaganda images and videos on the Internet;
- Possession of propaganda material promoting violence (pamphlets, books, videos, DVDs, music, websites, etc.);
- Eliciting information: asking personnel questions in relation to infrastructure, schedules, etc.;
- Online research in order to perpetrate an attack;
- Reconnaissance of a possible target;
- Unusual reconnaissance or surveillance/ Taking photos for reconnaissance purposes;
- Suspicious overflight of drone, airplane or helicopter, etc.;
- Breaking and entering/ intrusion/ attempted intrusion/ security testing (physical or electronic);
- Suspicious theft/ loss/ misplacement or possession of (uniforms, keys, ID, etc.);
- Sabotage/ alteration/ vandalism.

The presence of one of the above-mentioned indicators does not necessarily signal criminal activity. However, the probability increases with the number of indicators detected. All signs must be examined in context. **If you are in doubt, contact the Combined Intelligence Group.**
