

Eligibility of Lighting Projects

Because of the nature of electrical projects, **we cannot guarantee the eligibility of any electrical projects**. Once your applications are submitted, our contractor reviews all the applications to ensure the projects are feasible within the scope of this grant. While this list is not comprehensive, here are a few learnings we have about what makes a project eligible or ineligible.

Generally speaking, we

- Cannot do any projects that require construction (i.e. accessing or adding wiring or infrastructure in the walls, ceiling or floors/ground)
- Cannot add lighting infrastructure, such as poles.
- Cannot work on City of Calgary or ENMAX poles or lines.
- Can change lightbulbs in existing fixtures.



We can replace outdoor rink or court lighting with existing infrastructure.

We cannot install or replace the poles or infrastructure.



For Indoor Rinks, we can replace the lights if they are hanging down from the ceiling.

We cannot replace any lights that are embedded into the ceilings or walls.



We can add outdoor lighting to the sides of the building, as long as there are electrical outlets or wiring on the exterior.

We also cannot use poles or wiring that are drawn from The City of Calgary or ENMAX infrastructure.

How can you tell if a pole is from the City or ENMAX?

Think about the flow of electricity. If the electricity is coming from your building to the pole or infrastructure, it is likely that we can work on those projects. If the electricity is coming from the grid, it is likely a City or ENMAX line and pole, and we cannot work on it.



Security lighting around your building such as, lights by your entryways, around your garbage/waste bins, lights along your pathways or walkways, or lights on the side of your building to discourage loitering or other activities.



We can replace lights around walkways as long as there is existing wiring & infrastructure.



We can add motion or photocell (light) sensors to reduce energy-usage.
